

# MARQUETTE GIVES

Southwest Regional Giving Committee Approves Grants  
\$75,000 to Phoenix and Southern California Nonprofits

The Marquette Financial Companies Southwest Regional Giving Committee recently approved unrestricted general operating grants totaling \$75,000 to ten nonprofit organizations serving residents of the Phoenix and Southern California metropolitan areas. Grants ranged from \$3,000 to \$15,000 for financial literacy education, affordable housing development, food shelves, domestic women's shelter and community economic development.

The grants are the first approved by the committee which was created to increase giving in regions where Marquette operating companies are located. Local business employees consider and select organizations that receive support.
